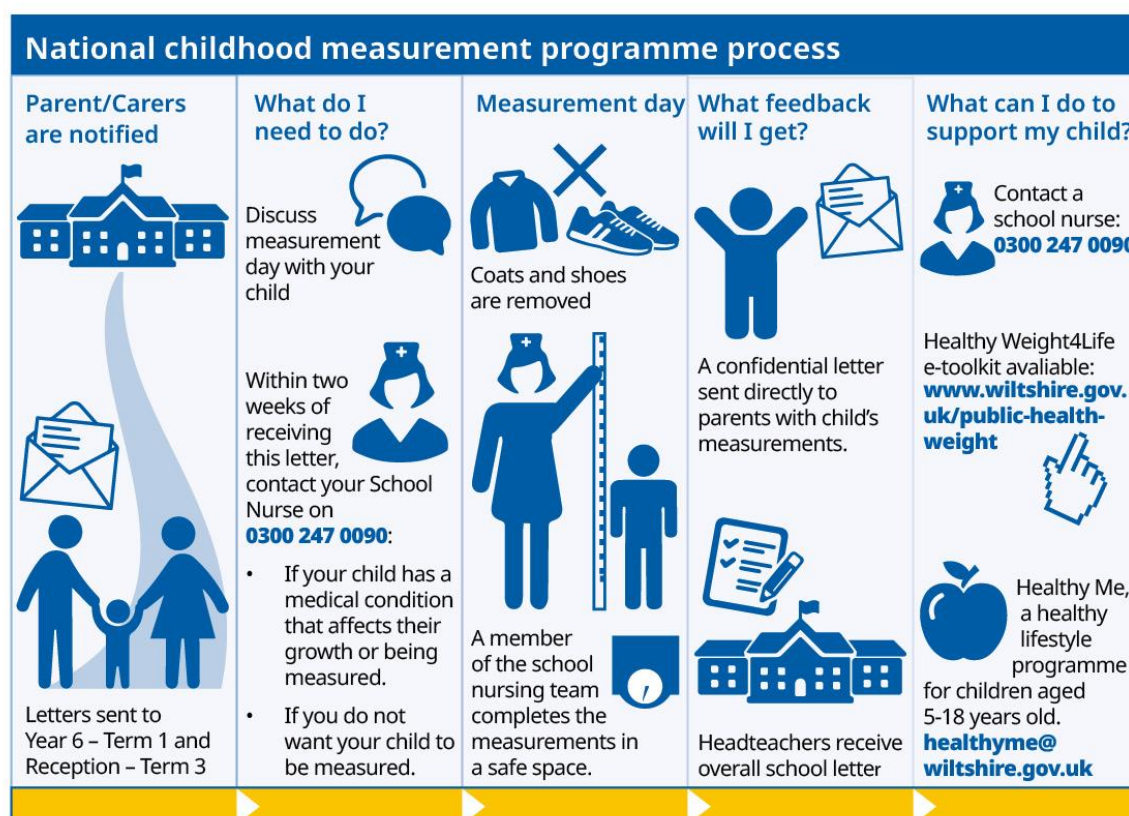

Every year in England, children in Reception and Year 6 have their height and weight checked at school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP). Your child's class will take part in this year's programme



Why should my child participate?

The data gained from NCMP, helps schools and Local Authorities better plan for programmes, services and resources to support families' physical and emotional health and wellbeing where it is needed most.


