



Height and weight checks for children in Reception and Year 6

Every year in England, children in Reception and Year 6 have their height and weight checked at school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP). Your child's class will take part in this year's programme.



Why should my child participate?

The data gained from NCMP, helps schools, health services and local authorities better plan for programmes, services, and resources to support families' physical and emotional health and wellbeing where it is needed most.
