

Communication and Language/ Literacy

We will:

- Listen to rhyming words and identify rhyme.
- Listen to and hear initial sounds of words.
- Orally blend and segment sounds in words.
- Learn phase 3 phonic sounds
- Use magnetic letters to make CVC words.
- Learn new words and vocabulary through stories
- Sequence and retell a story
- Write character descriptions
- Draw and label a woodland animal
- Write facts in bullet points
- Practice letter formation in families

Mathematics

We will:

- Counting forwards and backwards up to 20
- Compare length of objects using longer, shorter and equal to
- Recognise that amounts get one more as we count
- Recognise the total in a group of objects just by looking (subitising).
- Explore symmetry
- Explore composition, how 5, 6, 7 is made using 5 and a bit
- Learn ordinal numbers 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
- Compare capacity using language such as full and empty

- Continue to strengthen the muscles in our hands through fine motor activities in the classroom.
- Practice throwing and catching skills in PE. routines.
- Learn a Lunar New Year dance.
