

Communication and Language/ Literacy

- We will recap Phase 3 phonics sounds and use them to blend words.
- Sing rhymes and familiar songs.
- Practise writing recognisable letters, using the correct formation.
- Mark make with a range of materials- chinks, paint, sand, crayons.
- Describing familiar things and items from stories.
- Label different parts of a dinosaur.
- We will write questions using a question mark
- Writing a letter to a dinosaur.

Mathematics

- We will reading and writing addition number sentences to 10.
- Look more at take away and writing number sentences.
- We will compare numbers to 10 and talk about which is bigger and which is smaller.
- We will begin to look at money: 1ps, 2ps and 5ps.
- Estimating amounts beyond 5 and distances.
- We will measure capacity and weight using words such as full, empty, heavy and light.

Physical Development

- We will be learning ball skills: catching, throwing, kicking, underarm rolls and striking.
- Experiment moving to different themes.
- Perform with West End in Schools.
