- -We will recap Phase 3 phonics sounds and use them to blend and spell words.
- -Sing rhymes and familiar songs.
- -Practise writing recognisable letters, using the correct formation.
- -Mark make with a range of materials- chalks, paint, sand, crayons.
- We will be writing facts about sea animals,
- -Label items in our seaside buckets,
- -We will make a wanted poster about a missing mermaid.
- -Talk and write about sharing.

Understanding the World

- We will explore water: what things move in water, what items float and what animals live in water.
- Look at maps of our town and our world.
- We will look at oceans and the seaside.
- Understand who the Queen is and celebrate the Queen's Jubilee
- Learn about what life was like when our grown-ups were children.
