In our Understanding the World sessions, we will be learning about different animals, where they live and what they eat. Additionally, this term we will be celebrating and learning and Lunar New Year and visiting the Chinese Restaurant.

We will be learning new sounds with two letters (digraphs) such as ch, sh, etc. Please look out for the phonics stickers in the reading records. Learning these new sounds and recapping the old sounds is beneficial to the children's reading and writing and we would be very grateful if you could continue to practise these sounds at home.

Starting next week, we will be sending home a spelling activity pack. This will be updated each Friday and will include new words to practise each week, following on from work we have been doing in class. We would be very grateful if you could find a small amount of time to practise spelling these words on the sheet with your child, and it would be helpful for us if you could comment or show an example of your child trying any of the activities too. In addition, please continue to hear your child read at home.

Finally, please could you check that you have returned PE bags with indoor and outdoor PE kits. Thank you.
