

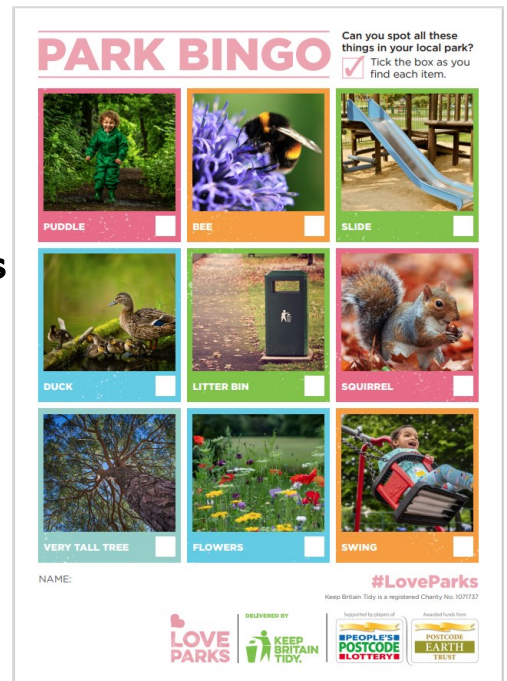
Things to do in the Summer holidays

ENCOMPASS**
In every force. In every school. For every child.

Our school is part of Operation Encompass which is a national scheme that operates jointly between schools and police forces.

Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has experienced domestic abuse.

As a school we have ensured that a member of our staff, known as a Key Adult, has been trained in the Operation Encompass procedures allowing us to then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to support the child/ren in our care.

Our Key Adult is: Mrs Pass, Headteacher & Designated Safeguarding Lead.

The Domestic Abuse Act 2021 identifies children who experience domestic abuse as victims of domestic abuse in their own right.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.



Computing and Online Safety



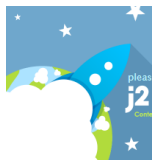

At Wootton Bassett Infants' School we encourage the children to use technology in lots of different ways. We understand that it can sometimes be difficult to keep your children entertained over the summer break so we have listed some helpful ways in which your children can engage with technology whilst remaining safe online.



With [ScratchJr](#), young children (ages 5-7) learn important new skills as they program their own interactive stories and games.

The [Raspberry Pi Foundation](#) is a free online platform where young people can learn to make stuff with code. Their online projects are completely free, they include step-by-step instructions, and you can easily filter them by level and topic. The projects are designed so that young people can complete them in no



[Just2Easy](#) is a great online platform where children can write, draw, animate or mix the skills to make an e-book. .

Computing doesn't always mean using a computer or device. There are excellent 'unplugged' activities at [Barefoot Computing](#) that don't require a screen. I recommend the Mini Missions which are an excellent way of improving the children's computing skills without using any technology.



Screen Time Advice

Screen time can offer children opportunities to learn and develop new skills at a touch of a button but like anything, too much of it can have a negative effect on their wellbeing.

- Tip 1- Set digital rules together
- Tip 2- Stay engaged in their screen use
- Tip 3- Discuss online risks and strategies to tackle them
- Tip 4- Set a good example with your own screen use
- Tip 5- Use tech tools to manage their time and access to media

Remember to talk to your child regularly about what they're doing online and how to stay safe. Let them know they can come to you or another trusted adult if they're feeling worried or upset by anything they have seen.
