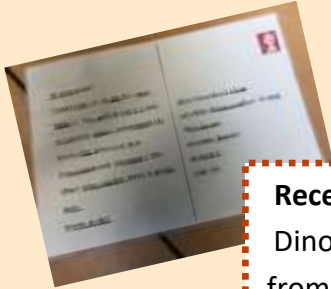




Writing

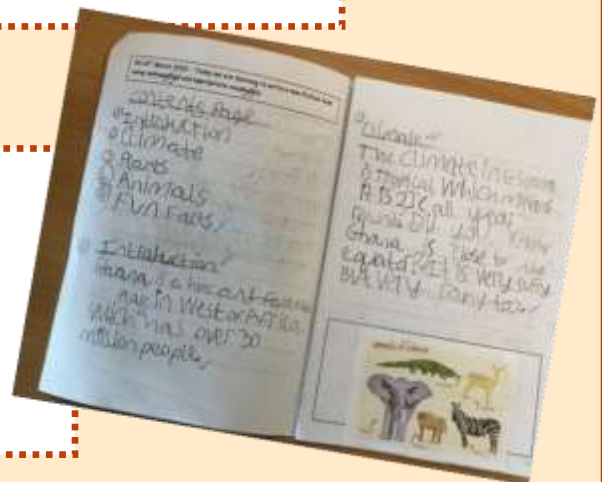
