

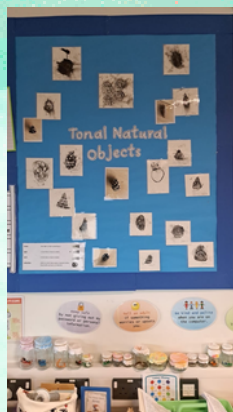
# Wootton Bassett Infants' School
