
# Out of This World

to write labels, and poems. We will also be writing instructions on how we would catch a star. We will be looking at Neil Armstrong and creating a




fact file about his life. We will watch clips of the moon landing and hear those very famous words!

We will start the term by looking at 2D and 3D shapes. We will investigate patterns and some properties these


shapes have.

#### Science

#### Art and DT

#### Computing

We will be learning how to use the directional keys using programmes on Purple Mash.

#### History

We will focus our learning about Neil Armstrong and Mae Jamison as historical figures in space.

During our PSHE lessons we will be learning about the people in our community and our wider world

#### RE- Religious Education

We will be thinking about people who are special to us.

#### Music

In music the children will be learning about dynamics and pitch of instruments and our voices.
