## Arrangements for the Day

- We shall be leaving promptly at 9.10 am, after registration, so please can you ensure your child is here at 9.00 am. We will return to school by 3pm
- All children will need a packed lunch including a drink/s no glass bottles
  or fizzy drinks please. We would recommend sending a drink in your
  child's water bottle. If possible, please put in a <u>small</u> backpack, as the
  children will need to carry it. Although infant children are eligible for
  free school lunches every day, it would be very helpful if you could provide
  a packed lunch for this day. If this is likely to cause a problem, please
  contact the school office as soon as possible.
- Children can wear non-uniform.
  - Long trousers or leggings are advisable, even in hot weather, as the children will be sitting on hay bales and walking through farmland.
  - o Jumper/sweatshirt.
  - A sun hat would also be advisable if the weather is hot and sun cream should be applied at home.
  - Sensible sturdy footwear is essential (no open toed or slip on shoes)
     Wellies will also be needed if the weather is wet.
  - And if it is wet, please could you provide a waterproof coat or jacket.
