English



We will be using the classic books Owl babies and the Tiger who came to tea to talk about families and learn more about your child. The

children will use these stories to write labels, speech bubbles and shopping lists. We will also explore the traditional tale of Golidlocks and the three bears and write simple character descriptions. To-

wards the end of the term we will start our learning on a longer text; Alice in Wonderland. We will be watching clips of the film and sharing books of the story.



Maths

We will start by embedding previous reception maths experiences by exploring counting and pattern.



We will then move on to place value to 100. This will involve lots of counting and learning that making groups of 10 means we can count objects more reliably. The children will also be learning about number lines and the value of numbers, using practical resources to demonstrate their place value using the language of tens and ones .



Meet my folks

Science

We will be learning about our bodies and our senses. When we learn about our bodies we will be learning about our external body parts, our skeletons and our internal organs. We will also be exploring outside to investigate the season of Autumn.

Art and DT

After completing our self portraits we will be creating our family portrait and using wooden sticks to frame it. We will be studying the painting tiger in a tropical storm.



Computing
We will be learning how to keep safe online.

<u>Geography</u>

We will start by labelling a simple plan of our classrooms, then move on to learning the compass points, drawing a map of our school using a key before creating of our map of wonderland.

PSHE (Personal, Social, Health Education)

During our PSHE lessons we will be learning about our bodies and how we can keep our bodies healthy.

<u>Rt- Religious Education</u> We will be thinking about different groups we belong to and what it feels like to belong to different religions.

Music

We will be using a programme called Charanga. Our first topic is called 'Hey You'.

(Can your child feel their heart beating? Try it before and after completing 20 star jumps)


What animal would you like to come to tea at your house?
