We will be taking our Year 2 children for swimming lessons at the Lime Kiln Leisure Centre in Royal Wootton Bassett. The Lime Kiln provides 3 swimming teachers, and the children will be split into groups based on their current swimming ability. This will be assessed during their first lesson.

These lessons traditionally take place during Term 6 but as you may be aware the Lime Kiln is currently undergoing extensive refurbishment meaning the pool will be closed for a period of time.

As a result, the lessons will start next week, continue after half term and be completed at the end of the school year.

- Goggles can be worn only if the child can put them on and off themselves. The swimming teachers may ask them to remove them if they prove a distraction.

Please ensure <u>everything</u> your child wears and brings with them is clearly named (a sharpie will do the job).

Children who are not taking part will still walk to the pool and watch from the spectator area.
