

## English

The children will complete instruction writing for keeping a plant healthy before moving onto descriptions using Monkey Puzzle and The Enormous Crocodile. We will also write fact-files for Amazon Rainforest animals using our reading skills to help us. This term, the children will also be completing the Year One Phonics Check.

### Science

We will continue to learn about plants this term, before moving onto all living things in the rainforest.

## Geography

We will use atlases and maps to find locations. The children will compare the UK to life of the Awa Tribe in the Amazon.

#### RE

This term we will answer the question: Why is God important to Muslims? as the children learn about Islam.

#### Maths

This term we will be learning about addition and subtraction for numbers up to 20. Place value up to 100 and recognising and using the following coins; lp, 2p, 5p and 10p. this will also include counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

#### Art

Our Art will focus on sculptures and 3D models using the Rainforest as inspiration.

#### PSHE

We will look at changes and moving onto Year 2.

### Music

The children will create their own compositions using different instruments.
