- All float aids will be provided
- No googles (please speak to Mrs Farr in the office if this is an issue)

On swimming days, please send your child into school wearing either their PE kit or sportswear including appropriate footwear. We will send PE kits home on Thursday's but please remember to bring it back for Monday. As the children will be walking to the pool, we suggest that they have a small backpack to carry their towel and swimwear.

They will also need either a hat or coat dependant on the weather.

Please ensure <u>everything</u> your child wears and brings with them is clearly named (a sharpie will do the job).

Children who are not taking part will still walk to the pool and watch from the spectator area.
