The children have missed so much time out of school and we want to see them here as much as possible.



Y1 & Y2

All year 1 & 2 children return to school on Thursday 2nd September. You will need to take your children to the lower playground and wait there until your children are collected by their class Teacher or TA. The gates to the playground will open at 8.50am. Children must be in school by 9am for registration.

Late children will need to report to the school office.

The school day finishes at 3pm. Collection is in the lower playground and the gates will open at 2.50pm. The children will be dismissed to you by their teacher. If you are not collecting your child and you have made alternate arrangements, please ensure you notify the school office.

The reception children will start their induction on Monday 6th September.

Children should be taken to the top playground where you will wait with your child until they are collected by their class teacher or TA. The gates will open at 8.50am and children need to arrive no later than 9am. Late arrivals and absences must be reported to the school office.

We will open the gates 10 mins before pick up and drop off times. When collecting your child/ren please wait in the top playground and the teacher or TA will dismiss them from their classrooms. If you have made alternative arrangements for your child's collection you must notify the school office.

If you have children in Reception and other year groups please drop off and pick up your reception child first. Thank you
