World Book Day is celebrated all over the world every year. However, at Wootton Bassett Infants we like to go that little bit further, we celebrate all week!

Our book focus this year is 'The Owl & the Pussycat' by Edward Lear and we have planned lots of exciting classroom activities, events and visits throughout the week.

### Monday 27th February

Assembly = Mrs Pass & Miss Noyes will be starting of the week with an assembly introducing World Book Week and 'The Owl & the Pussycat'.

### Tuesday 28th February
