We have made watches out of tubes and card



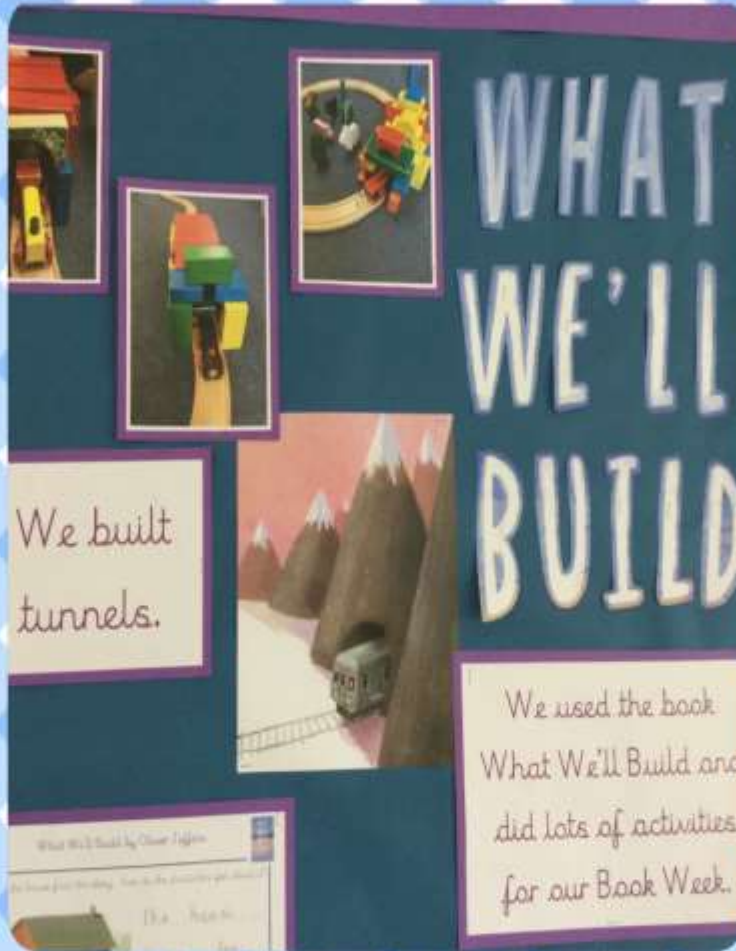
We have made hammocks and bridges out of card and we used tape to secure it.

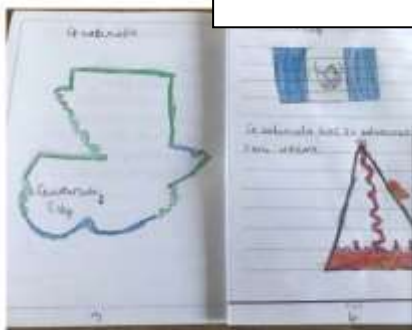


# Geography
